

PURE HONEY INCLUDING ORGANIC HONEY FROM AFRICAN COUNTRIES

1. Additional declaration on the phytosanitary certificate that-
 - 1.1 the country of production is free from:
 - (a) *Paenibacillus larvae*
 - (b) *Nosema ceranae*
2. On arrival an audit sample will be drawn and sent to a laboratory for testing and be found free from these pests.

BEESWAX, ROYAL JELLY COLLECTED BY HONEYBEES FOR MEDICINAL PURPOSES AND BIOREMEDIATION ONLY

Each consignment shall be:

1. packed in sealed durable packaging and bees wax shall be packed in cans/canisters sealed with tight fitting lids. The lid shall be fitted with a lever to ensure tight fitting of the lid; packed and transported in such a way that no spillage shall occur
2. inspected on arrival at the prescribed port of entry by the Executive Officer in terms of Agricultural Pests Act, 1983 (Act No. 36 of 1983). Should no leakage (s) occur the importer shall be permitted by means of written consent from the Executive Officer, to transport the consignment to the importer's premises
3. only be used for medicinal purposes only

PURE HONEY, ROYAL JELLY, BEESWAX, PROPOLIS OR POLLEN COLLECTED BY HONEYBEES OR PRODUCTS CONTAINING ANY OF THESE

1. The Importer shall arrange with the Manager of Irradiation Plant (paragraph 2.3b) prior to import of consignment, for immediate irradiation thereof. Written approval for removal from the port of entry must be obtained from the Executive Officer of the Agricultural Pests Act, 1983 (Act No. 36 of 1983) before removal to the irradiation plant.
2. Each consignment shall be:
 - 2.1 packed in sealed durable packaging and honey shall be packed in cans/canisters sealed with tight fitting lids. The lid shall be fitted with a lever to ensure tight fitting of the lid; packed and transported in such a way that no spillage shall occur;
 - 2.2 **FOR PURE HONEY** each consignment shall be:
 - (a) packed in cans/canisters not exceeding 610 mm in diameter and the height thereof to be determined by the Manager of the relevant Irradiation Plant;
 - (b) packed and transported in such a way, leaving \pm 100 mm head space for allowance of expansion during transport and irradiation;
 - 2.3 the consignment shall be packed in sealed containers according to the specifications accepted by the Irradiation Plant and shall only be irradiated in the container(s) in which the material was imported.
 - 2.4 consigned by the supplier in the foreign country in the name of the Importer directly to one of the following facilities:
 - (a) GAMMASTER (PTY) LTD, 1 Waterpas Road, Isando;
 - (b) GAMWAVE (PTY) LTD, 19 The Avenue East, Prospecton, Durban.
 - (c) HEPRO CAPE (PTY) LTD, 6 Ferrule Avenue, Montague Gardens, Cape Townfor irradiation at a minimum **absorbed dosage of 10 kGy** and a maximum absorbed dosage of 20 kGy; and
 - 2.5 irradiated at an Irradiation Plant that is nearest to the point of entry;
 - 2.6 inspected on arrival at the port of entry by the Executive Officer of the Agricultural Pest Act, 1983 (Act No. 36 of 1983). Should no leakage (s) occur the importer shall be permitted by means of written consent from the Executive Officer, to transport the consignment to the relevant Irradiation Plant
3. On arrival at the Irradiation Plant, the importer or his agent shall inform the Executive Officer of the date and time of opening of containers with cans and canisters. Containers shall only be opened under supervision of the Executive Officer.

Honey shall only be irradiated in the original sealed cans/canisters in which the honey was imported.

IMPORTATION OF USED APIARY EQUIPMENT

1. The equipment shall be consigned in the name of the importer directly to one of the following:
 - (d) GAMMASTER (PTY) LTD, 1 Waterpas Road, Isando; Johannesburg
 - (e) GAMWAVE (PTY) LTD, 19 The Avenue East, Prospecton, Durban.
 - (f) HEPRO CAPE (PTY) LTD, 6 Ferrule Avenue, Montague Gardens, Cape Townfor irradiation at a minimum **absorbed dosage of 10 kGy.**
 - The consignment must be declared at the port of entry and sent by way of an order executed by the executive officer to the relevant Irradiation Plant.
 - Removal of the consignment from above premises shall be subject to written confirmation by the relevant Plant Manager that the prescribed irradiation treatment has been applied.
2. Irradiation treatment shall be done at the importer's risk, the Department of Agriculture will by no means be held liable for any damage or loss resulting from such prescribed treatment.
3. The importer shall be responsible for all expenses involved.
