PERMITTED TECHNIQUES: All including Digital photography. *Photos may be submitted in black and white or in colour.*

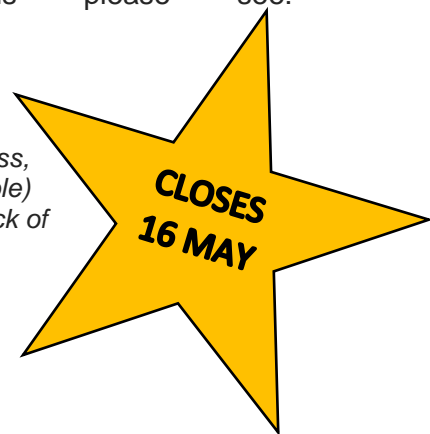
Art Works can be in any medium.

PUBLISHED: Winning items (Placed 1st – 3rd) in all categories will be show cased in the Honey Hall during the Royal Show to be held in Pietermaritzburg from 27 May – 5 June. In addition to this, all these winners will be published in the South African Bee Journal. Each photograph/artwork will be credited to its Artist and will include the description submitted. All participants will receive, free of charge, a copy of the South African Bee Journal edition that published the results.

RETURN OF NON-WINNING ENTRIES: All non-winning photographs and art works submitted on paper/canvas will be returned to the artist at the owner's expense at the end of the exhibition if so requested on submission.

All non-returned photographs will be added to SABIO's archives and credited to the author.
